INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR OWN EMPLOYEES, SUPPLIERS, CUSTOMERS AND CUSTOMERS SUPPLIERS

Regarding the situation with Coronavirus / COVID-19, it is a requirement that all employees, customers, suppliers and customers' suppliers show extended responsibility - both in relation to themselves, colleagues and the other surroundings. This is done, for example, by following the Danish authorities' instructions. These can be read in both Danish and English at www.sst.dk/corona.

The 5 recommendations from the authorities are:

- Wash your hands frequently or sanitize your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub
- Cough or sneeze into your sleeve, not your hands
- Limit physical contact – avoid handshakes, refuse kisses on the cheek and avoid hugging
- Be diligent with cleaning – both at home and in your workplace
- Keep your distance and ask others to be considerate

In addition, Orskov Yard has introduced that, face masks must be worn:

- When driving in trucks with more than two people
- In the common canteen
- In the administration building on South dep. and the master's office on North dep.
- During ALL meetings on Orskov Yard

Foreign inspectors, business travelers and migrant labor

Foreign inspectors, representatives, business travelers and migrant workers residing in high-risk countries

(<https://coronasmitte.dk/en/entry-into-denmark/is-my-country-open-or-banned>) who travel into Denmark and Orskov Yards with a recognizable purpose must present a negative COVID-19 test performed no later than 72 hours before the time of entry.

Persons residing in the border country (Norway, Schleswig-Holstein, Skåne, Halland or Blekinge) are not covered by the requirement to hold a test certificate.

Crew

According to the authorities, foreign seafarers have land permits in Danish ports. This pleases only ships at the quay or in the dock and not ships lying on the nest. All seafarers with Danish citizenship can get a land permit in Danish ports. Orskov Yard recommends that foreign crews do not go ashore when they are in the yard's areas.

Suspicion of Corona infection


If infection with the corona virus is suspected, it must be tested negative before access to Orskov Yard's area can be allowed.
