INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR OWN EMPLOYEES, SUPPLIERS, CUSTOMERS AND CUSTOMERS' SUPPLIERS

Regarding the situation with Corona virus / COVID-19, it is a requirement that all employees, customers, suppliers and customers' suppliers show extended responsibility - both in relation to themselves, colleagues and the other surroundings. This is done, for example, by following the Danish authorities' instructions. These can be read in both Danish and English at www.sst.dk/corona.

The 6 recommendations from the authorities are:

- Get vaccinated.
- Stay at home and get tested if you experience symptoms.
- Keep your distance.
- Open windows and doors and ventilate your home regularly.
- Wash hands frequently or use hand sanitize.
- Clean thoroughly and regularly, especially surfaces that are touched by many people.

Entry restrictions to Denmark:

For all foreign inspectors, representatives, business travelers and migrant workers entering from abroad to Orskov Yard, the authorities' travel restrictions apply, which can be found at <https://en.coronasmitte.dk/rules-and-regulations/entry-into-denmark>

Access to Orskov Yard's area

Access to Orskov Yard can only be allowed if you have a valid EU COVID-19 Pas/certificate.

Non-EU citizens shall upon request show proof of vaccination within the last 6 months, or a negative test result as documentation that for PCR test was taken within the past 72 hours and for a rapid antigen test (RAT) within the past 48 hours, or if you have previously been infected with COVID-19, you can use this as documentation by showing the result from your positive PCR test. Your positive PCR test must be at least 14 days old and maximum 6 months old to qualify as valid documentation.

Tests

Orskov Yard strongly recommends that EVERYBODY takes a Covid-19 test at least once a week.

Suspicion of Corona infection


If infection with the corona virus is suspected, a negative test must be shown before access to Orskov Yard's area can be allowed.

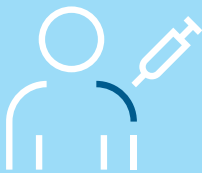

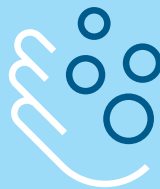
